Attracting private sector into investments

SDC India (Divya): difficulty of PPPs for resilience infrastructure

- Message to private sector: think long-term and multi-purpose / redundancy, focussing on resilience not profit alone
- Governments are deeply in debts -> can not do it alone

UK example

Nature-based solution: what is the return ratio?
